FEB-APRIL

SCHOOL- AND COUNTY-LEVEL SUBMISSIONS JUDGED

Students enter their projects at a school and/or county level placement competition. Winners are then forwarded to the regional level competition.

MAY 1ST

REGIONAL COMPETITION DEADLINE

First place winners in individual categories at the local level must be forwarded to the regional competition by May 1st to be judged.

JUNE 1ST

MOVING ON TO STATES!

First place winners in each category must be sent on to the state level competition by June 1st.
